Revit Architecture 2010 Intermediate – 4 days

Course Description

This course is intended for students who have completed Revit Architecture Fundamentals training and are ready to explore more advanced features in the software. Knowledge of basic techniques is assumed, such as creating walls, roofs, and other objects; copying and moving objects; creating and working with views; etc.

Course Prerequisite

Students should have completed the Revit Architecture Essentials course or have equivalent experience using Revit Architecture. Architectural design, drafting, or engineering experience is highly recommended. It is also recommended that the student have a working knowledge of Microsoft® Windows® XP or Microsoft® Windows® 2000.

Course Length and Class Hours

- The Revit Architecture 2010 Intermediate course is a three (4) day course.
- Training hours for the course are from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm.
